






Epidemiological Weekly Bulletin Syria EWARN

Highlights

- During Epi-week no 12, 2014; 75.8% (113/149) of the health facilities across 7 Governorates provided surveillance data; 100% of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time.
- The total number of consultations reported during the reporting week was **39845** (including 42.4% children under the age of five) compared to **34838** consultations during week 11. The leading cause of morbidity was FUO (Fever of Unknown Origin), with over 318 cases (0.79%).
- 88 alerts reported during the reporting week 12, 2014; including 46 alerts for suspected measles (186 cases), 18 for FUO, 4 for AJS, 11 for SARI, 7 for UCE (1 cluster for Leishmaniasis, 1 for whooping cough 5 for scabies), 1 for AFP.
- In week 12, we continue collecting data about measles cases by line list.
- •Data about new cases of Cutaneous leishmaniasis collected under other diseases; 150 new cases documented the most of them from Aleppo, Idleb & Ar-Raqqa.
- As of week 12, the total number of WPV cases reported by EWARN is 13 (type I) and 1 Sabine type 3. 1 AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) case reported this week
- Common disease reported under others were URTI (upper respiratory tract infection), acute diarrhea and others.



Proportion of morbidities among <5Y



EWARN Coverage


ACU EWARN covers 71/150 Sub-Districts in 7 Governorates. The total population currently under surveillance is about 7.189.528





Proportion of morbidities among ≥5Y




Trends for Leading Priority Diseases in 7 Governorates – Epi week 40, 2013 to Epi week 12, 2014:








Proportional Morbidity of Fever of Unknown Origin by Governorate, Epi Week 12:

Proportional Morbidity of Acute Jaundice Syndrome by Governorate, Epi Week 12:




Acute jaundice syndrome proportional morbidity is stable in all governorates.



Suspected measles proportional morbidity appears to be slightly increasing in some governorates. Lattakia had no cases of suspected measles in the last weeks

Epidemiological situation updates by governorate (week 12, 2014)

Aleppo:

In week 12, 14 alerts reported, including 10 for suspected measles (54 cases), 1 for UCE and 1 for AJS.

Idleb:

In week 12. 15 alerts were reported, 9 for measles (44cases), 3 for FUO, 1 for SARI and 1 for UCE.

Ar-Raqqa;

In week 12. $\overline{19}$ alerts reported, 12 for suspected measles (31 cases) and 7 for FUO.

Deir-ez-Zor:

In week 12, 33 alerts reported, 10 for MEA (33 cases), 8 for FUO, 9 for SARI, 1 AFP and 5 for UCE.

Hama:

In week 12, 4 alerts reported.3 for suspected measles and 1 for AJS.

Al Hasaka:

In week 12, 3 alerts reported for suspected measles (15 cases).

Latakia:

In week 12.no alerts.
