

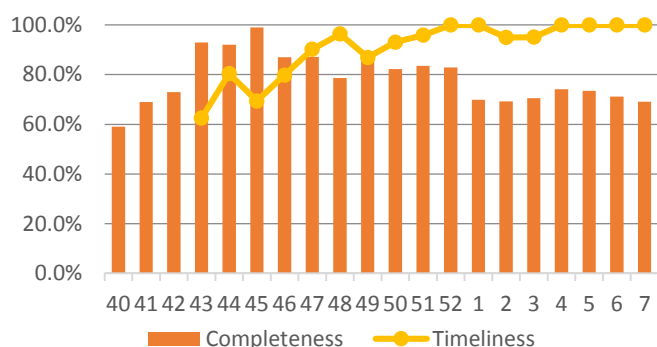
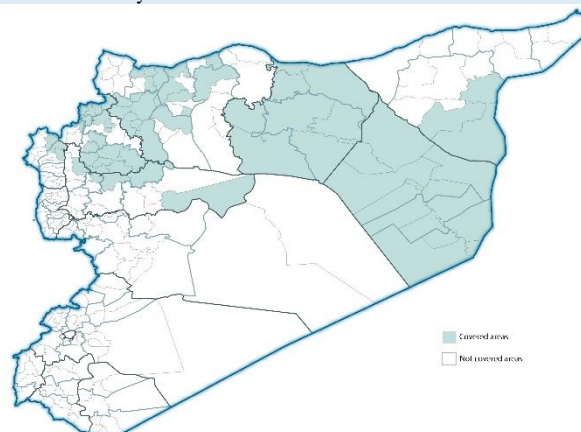
Epidemiological Weekly Bulletin Syria EWARN

Highlights

- During Epi-week no 07, 2014; 69.1% (103/149) of the health facilities across 7 Governorates provided surveillance data; 100% of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time.
- The total number of consultations reported during the reporting week was 37200 (including 43.3% children under the age of five) compared to 35754 consultations during week 6. The leading cause of morbidity was FUO (Fever of Unknown Origin), with over 248 cases (0.66%).
- 77 alerts reported during the reporting week 7, 2014; including 41 alerts for suspected measles, 13 for FOU, 6 for AJS, 11 for SARI, 1 for AFP.
- In week 07, we continue collecting data about measles cases by line list.
- As of week 06, the total number of WPV cases reported by EWARN is 13 (type 1) and 1 Sabine type 3. No AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) case reported this week.

EWARN Coverage

ACU EWARN covers 71/150 Sub-Districts in 7 Governorates. The total population currently under surveillance is about 7.189.528

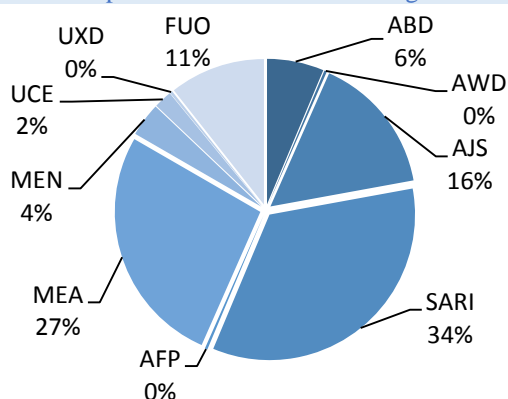

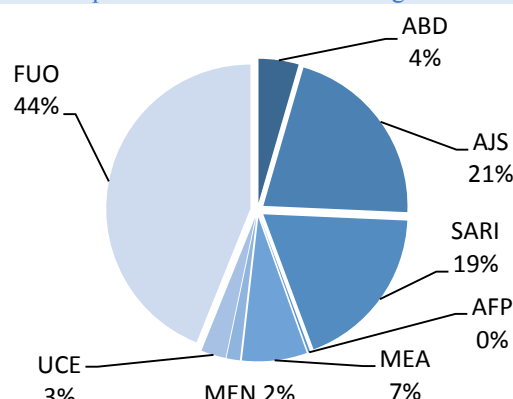

Proportion of morbidities among <5Y



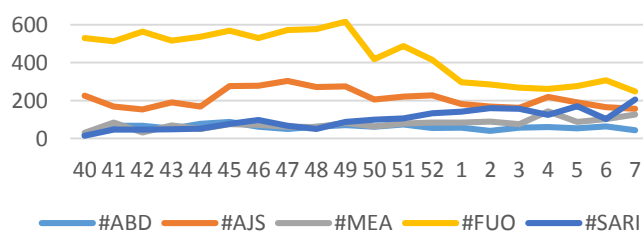
Proportion of morbidities among ≥5Y



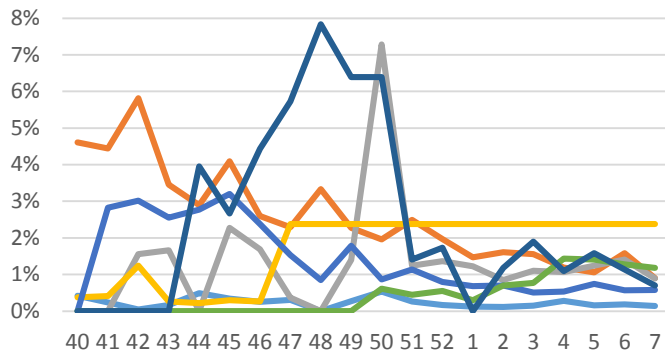

Trends for Leading Priority Diseases in 7 Governorates – Epi week 40, 2013 to Epi week 07, 2014:

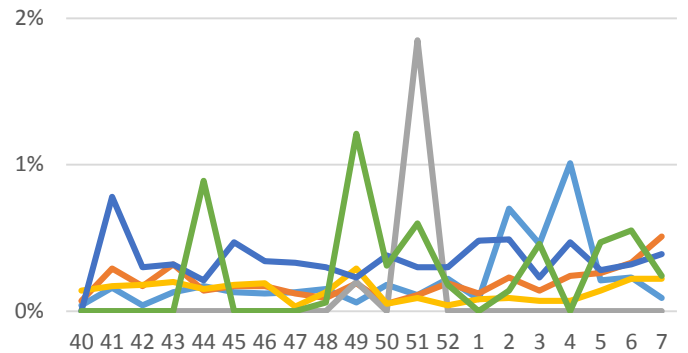


Proportional Morbidity of Fever of Unknown Origin by Governorate, Epi Week 07:



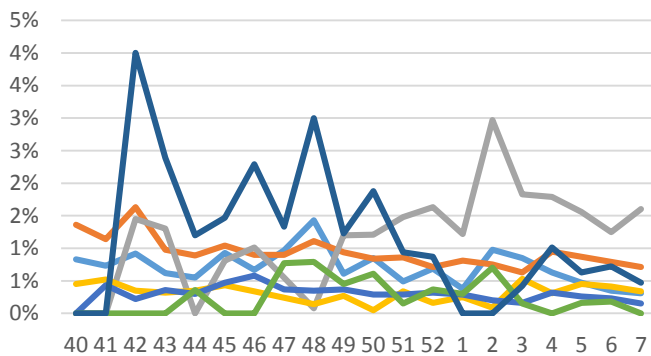
Fever of unknown origin (FUO) is a very non-specific syndrome. Majority of FUO cases are suspected to be typhoid fever.

Proportional Morbidity of suspected Measles by Governorate, Epi Week 07:



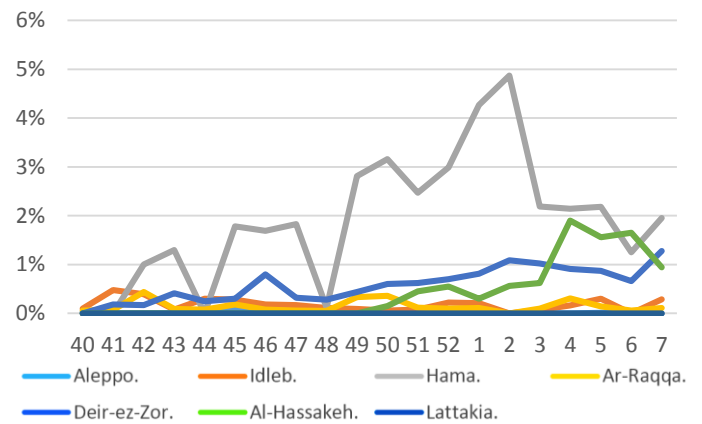
Suspected measles proportional morbidity appears to be slightly increasing in most governorates. Lattakia had no cases of suspected measles in the last weeks.

Epidemiological situation updates by governorate (week 06, 2014)

Aleppo:

In week 07, 5547 consultations reported from 19 health facilities in Aleppo governorate. 7 alerts reported, including 4 for suspected measles, 2 for Acute Jaundice Syndrome.

Idleb:

In week 07, 12623 consultations were reported from 25 health facilities in Idleb governorate. 23 alerts reported, including 15 for suspected measles, 3 for Acute Jaundice Syndrome and 4 for FUO (Sus. Typhoid fever) and 1 for SARI.

Ar-Raqqa:

In week 06, 5552 consultations reported from 19 health facilities in Ar-Raqqa governorate. 11 alerts reported; including 6 alerts for suspected measles, 4 for FUO and 1 for AFP.

Deir-ez-Zor:

In week 07, 11638 consultations reported from 31 health facilities in Deir-ez-Zor governorate. 32 alerts reported, including 15 for suspected measles, 4 for FUO, 9 for SARI.

Hama:

In week 07, 664 consultations reported from 3 health facilities. 1 alerts reported for SARI, and 1 alert reported for AJS.

Al Hasaka:

In week 07, 424 consultations reported from 3 health facilities. 1 alerts reported for suspected measles.

Lattakia:

In week 07, 852 consultations reported from 3 health facilities. 1 alerts reported for FUO.
