

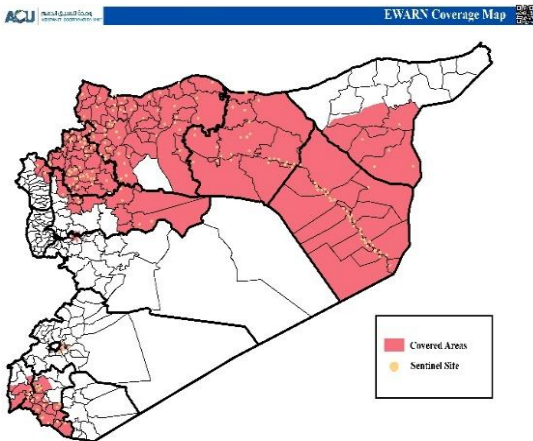
Highlights

- Employment new staff in northern rural of Al Hasakeh .
- FLOS training was held in Azaz district – northern of Aleppo.
- During Epi-week no 29 2015; 85% (443/378) of the health facilities across 12 Governorates provided surveillance data, 83% of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time.
- The total number of consultations reported during the reporting week was 103799 (including 40% children under the age of five) compared to 120459 consultations during week 28, 2015.
- In Epi week 29, 1 AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) case was reported in Menbij . Investigation for 157 AFP cases were conducted since the beginning of 2015 up to date. See weekly Acute Flaccid Paralysis Surveillance report for more details.
- 28 suspected measles cases reported in this week, the highest alerts were reported in Menbij (9). Lab investigation for 2 cases from Hama and Idleb with negative result.
- The number the STF cases (Suspected Typhoid Fever), was about 1690 cases, the highest alerts were reported in Deir ez zor (14).

- 500 cases of AJS , Lab investigation for 2 case in Idleb and Aleppo with negative result for HAV Ab.
- 153 cases of SARI reported in Epi Week 29, the highest alerts were reported in Homs (3).
- In Epi week 29: 8992 cases of Acute Diarrhea and 4049 cases of Influenza Like Illness were reported.
- Common disease reported under others were acute bronchiolitis (132 cases), chicken pox (109 cases), Brucellosis (67 cases), Pertussis , Scabies, Lice ,mumps , Cutaneous leishmaniasis, and Hand, foot and mouth diseases. 1 confirmed T.B case in Idleb.
- 45 new cases of Pertussis were reported this week, 34 of them were in Deir Hafir ,10 in Al Mayadin , and 1 in Abu Kamal.
- Investigation for 2 cases of visceral leishmaniasis in Afrin , both were female , 10 months and 3.5 years, diagnosed by bone marrow examination. The medication was provided by MENTOR initiative.
- 25 new cases of Hand, foot and mouth disease were reported in Daraa and Quneitra.
- 942 new cutaneous leishmaniasis cases reported this week, the alerts reported in 1 district: Afrin 1.

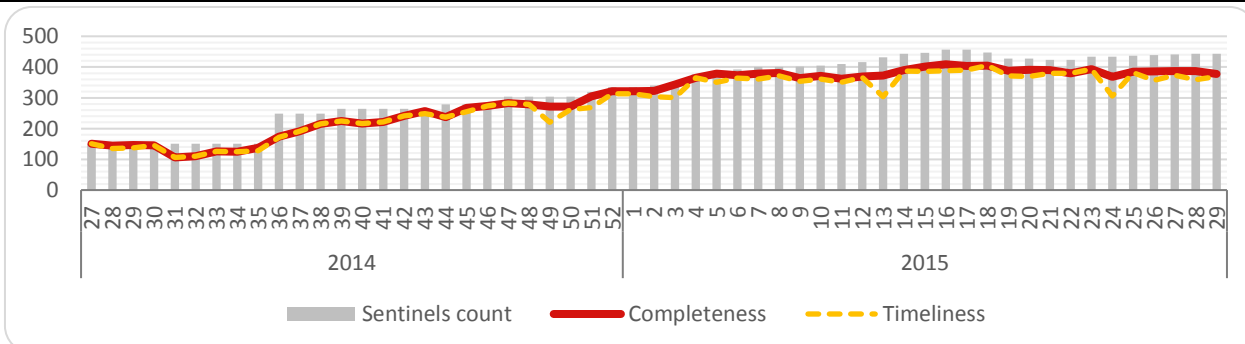
EWARN covers 113 sub districts in 12



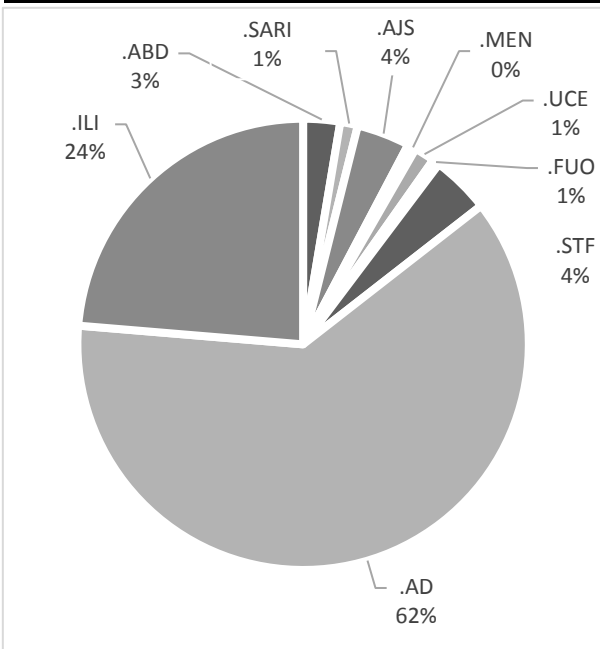

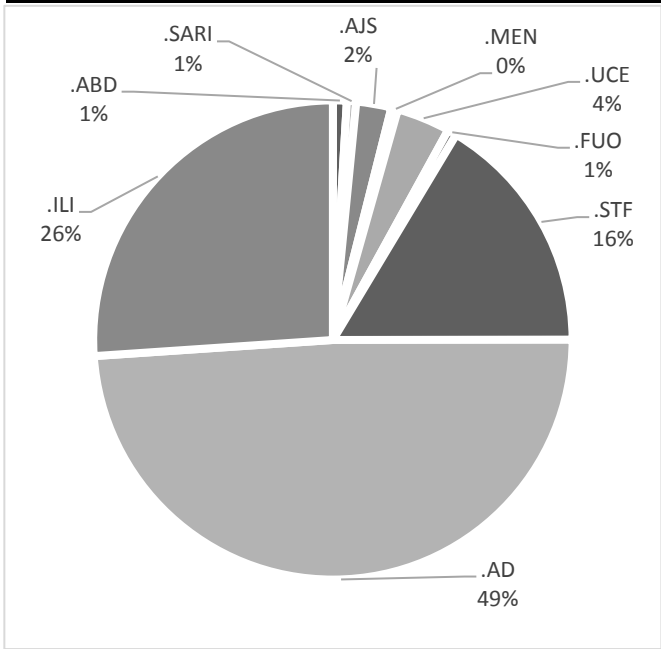

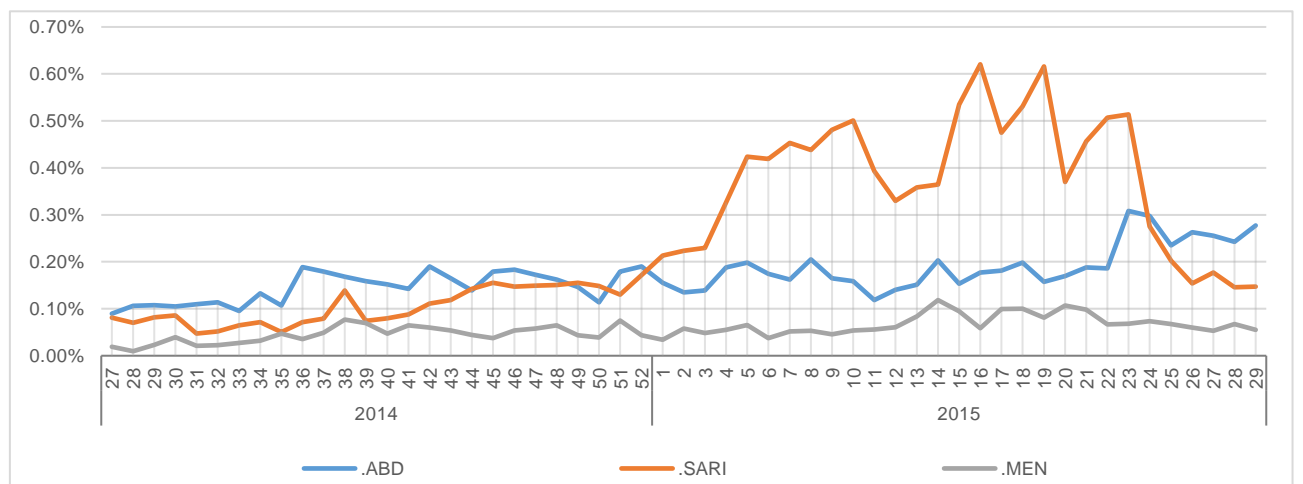
Percentage of EWARN Syndromes < 5Y



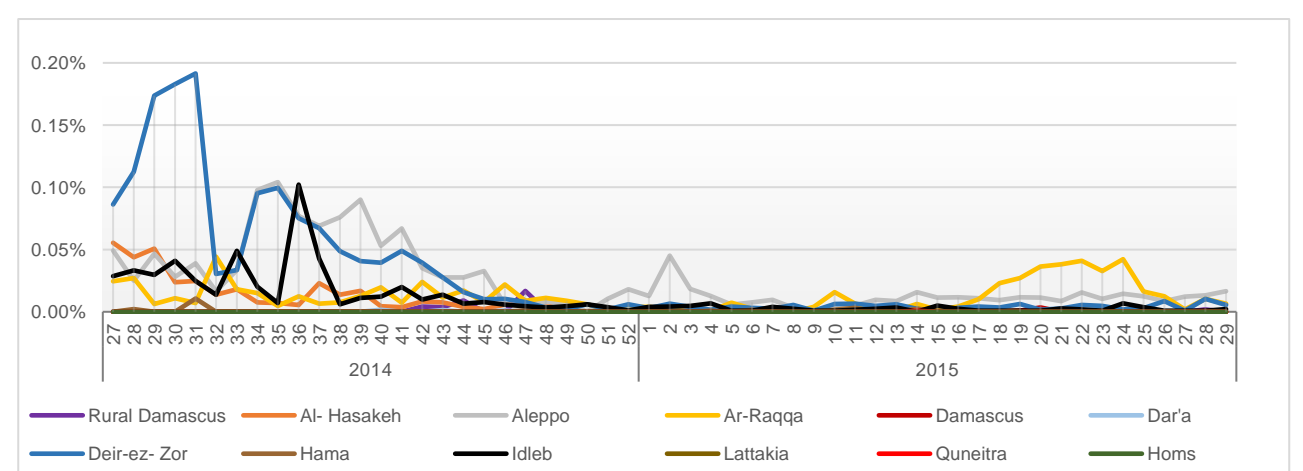
Percentage of EWARN Syndromes >=5Y



Trends for essential priority diseases in 12 governorates, Epi week 29 - 2015

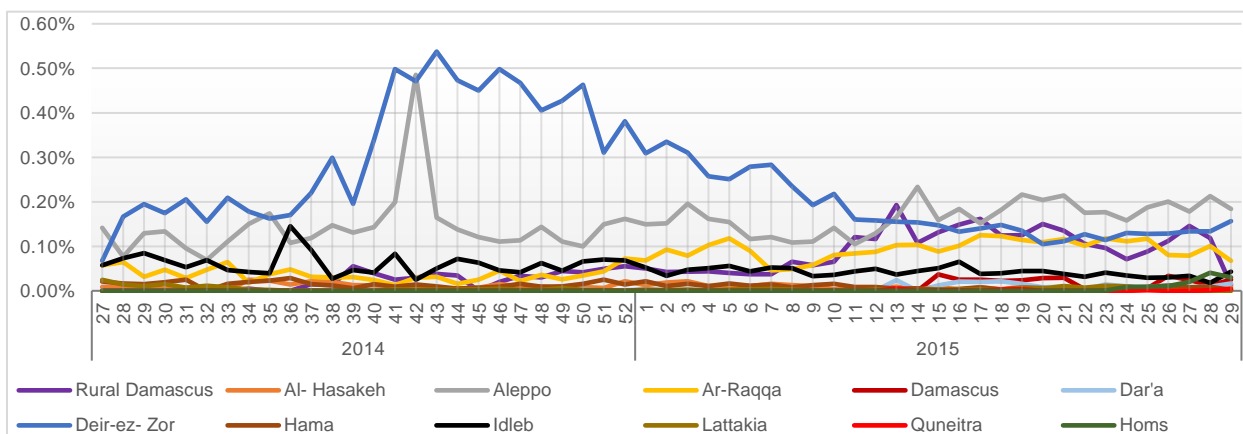


Proportional Morbidity of suspected Measles by Governorate, Epi Week 29 - 2015



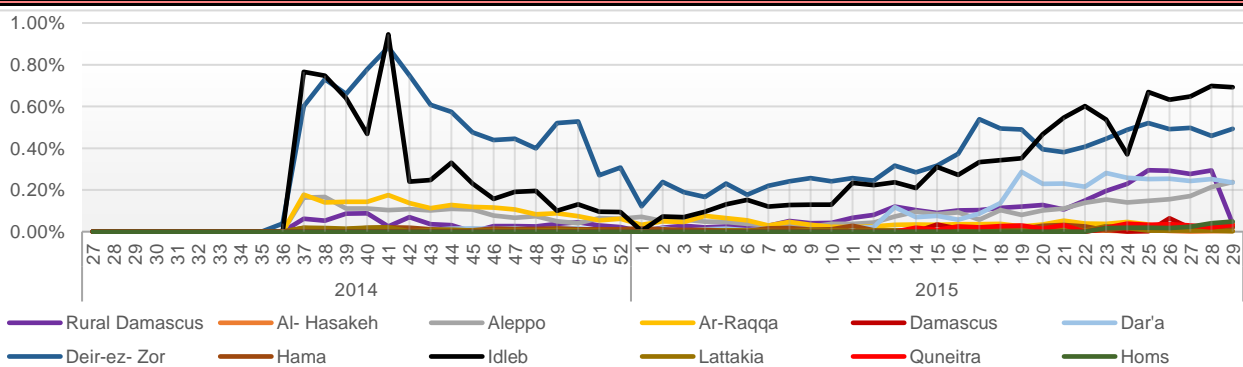
Proportional Morbidity of suspected AJS by Governorate, Epi Week
