

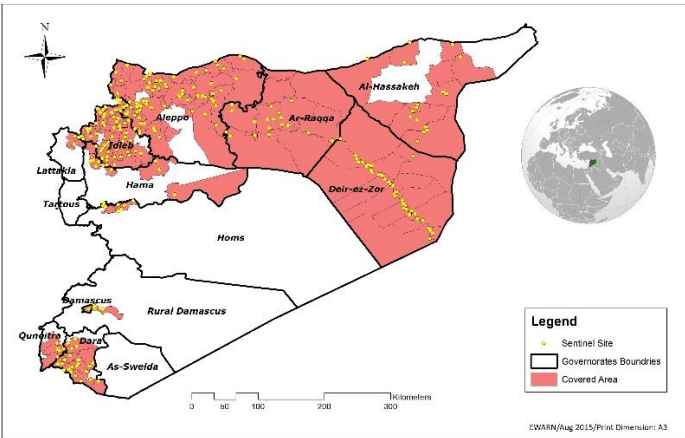
Highlights

- EWARN team in Dar'a and Quneitra has attended a training course in Jordan in between 24th August -3rd September , in the context of polio vaccination campaign in southern of Syria.
- During Epi-week no 36 2015; 96% (481/462) of the health facilities across 12 Governorates provided surveillance data , 88.5% of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time.
- The total number of consultations reported during the reporting week was 150077 (including 40% children under the age of five) compared to 149280 consultations during week 34, 2015.
- In Epi week 36, 3 AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) cases were reported in : Hafa , Al Bab and Afrin . Investigation for 191 AFP cases were conducted since the beginning of 2015 up to date. See weekly Acute Flaccid Paralysis Surveillance report for more details.
- 77 suspected measles cases reported in this week, the highest alerts were reported in Menbij (9).
- The number the STF cases (Suspected Typhoid Fever), was about 3585 cases, the highest alerts were reported in Deir ez zor (19).
- 327 cases of SARI reported in Epi Week 35, the highest alerts were reported in Ain Alarab (3) and Deir ez zor (3).
- In Epi week 36 : 12897 cases of Acute Diarrhea and 7086 cases of Influenza Like Illness were reported.

- Common disease reported under others were acute bronchiolitis (74 cases), chicken pox (121 cases), Brucellosis (59 cases), Pertussis (29) , Scabies, Lice ,mumps (6) , Cutaneous leishmaniasis, acute tonsillitis ,impetigo and Hand, foot and mouth diseases (28) . 4 new confirmed pulmonary T.B cases were reported from : Abu Kamal , Harim , Rural Damascus and Duma .
- One death due to acute meningitis was reported for 18 years old female from Tabaka - Araqqa after 10 days from signs beginning. The patient is suspected as tuberculosis meningitis (as she was living with her aunt which died because of T.B and her children referred for T.B treatment). She suffered from fever, headache, vomiting and meningeal signs with no response to antibiotic, she had also patchy area in the right lung apex, but sputum examination and tuberculin test were both negative. The patient referred for head CT scan and LB to Ar Raqqa then to Aleppo where she died.
- One case of confirmed visceral leishmaniasis was reported in Afrin – Sharran village, the patient is male baby 3.5 months old, the signs are fever , weight loss and pailor , during the last month . Bone marrow examination was positive whereas the RT was negative. The proper medication and insecticide bed nets were provided to the patient and the households.
- 1295 new cutaneous leishmaniasis cases reported this week, with 3 alerts in Al Mar'a , Harim and Jebel Saman districts

EWARN Coverage

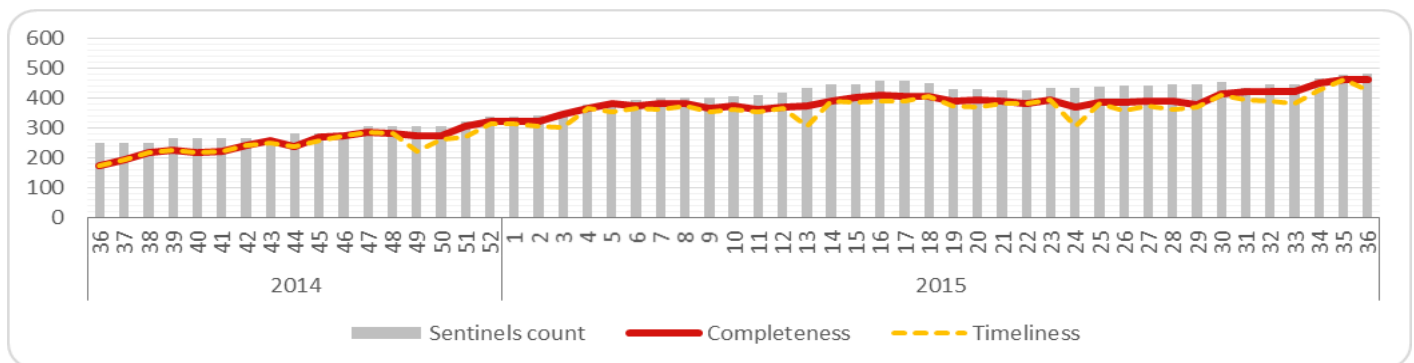
EWARN covers 110 sub districts and 37 districts in 12 governorates.



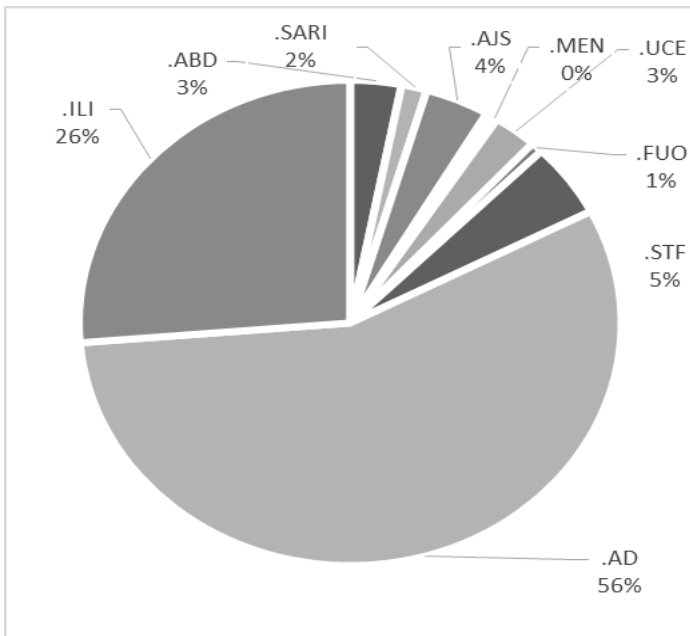

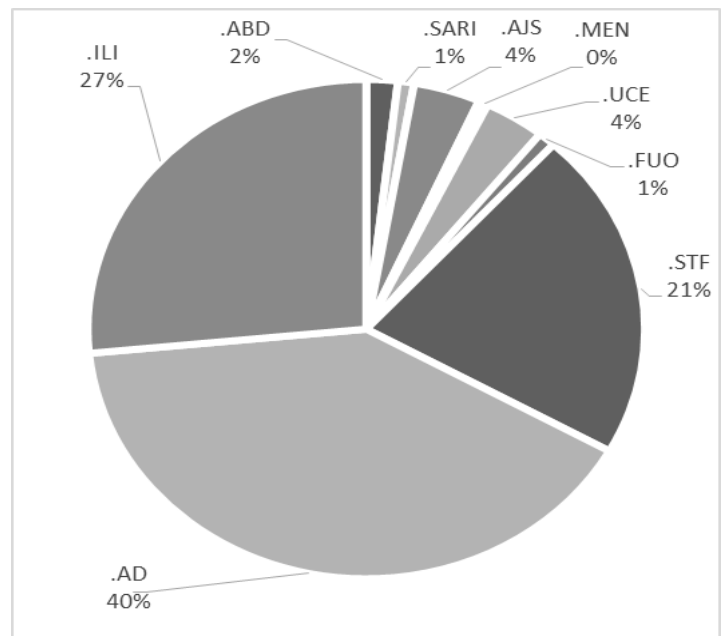

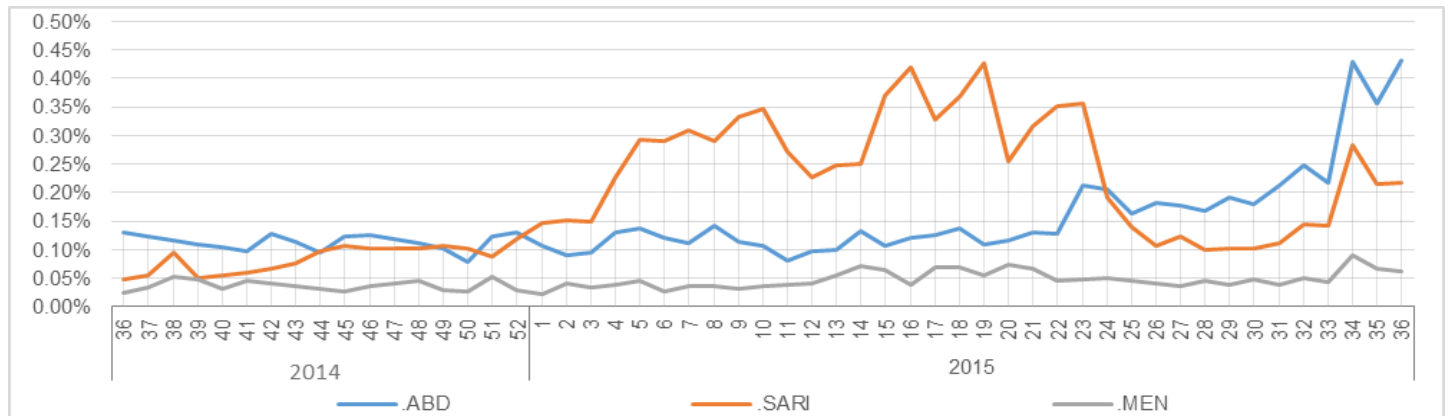
Percentage of EWARN Syndromes < 5Y



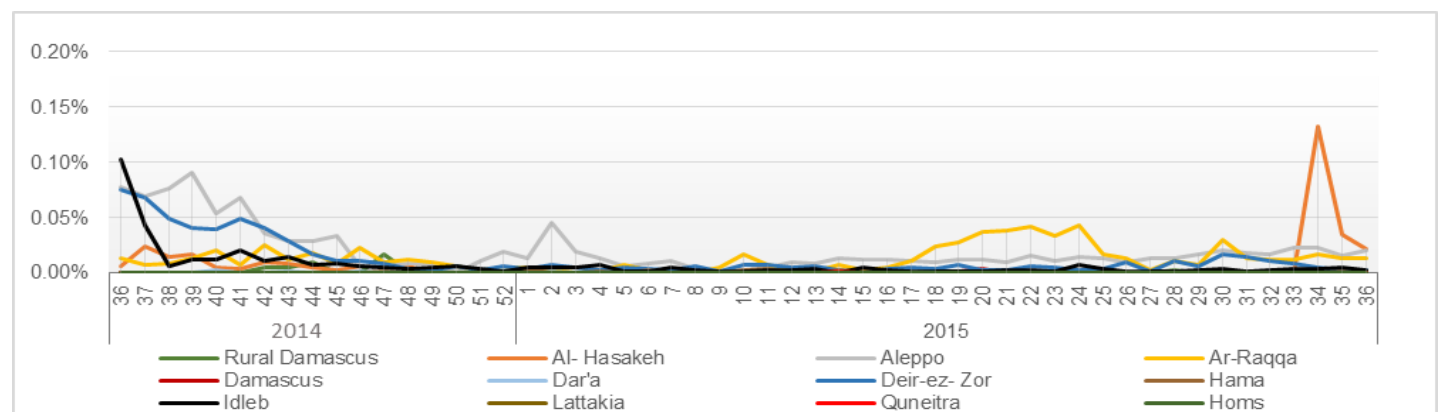
Percentage of EWARN Syndromes >=5Y



Trends for essential priority diseases in 12 governorates – Epi week 36-2014 to Epi week 36 - 2015

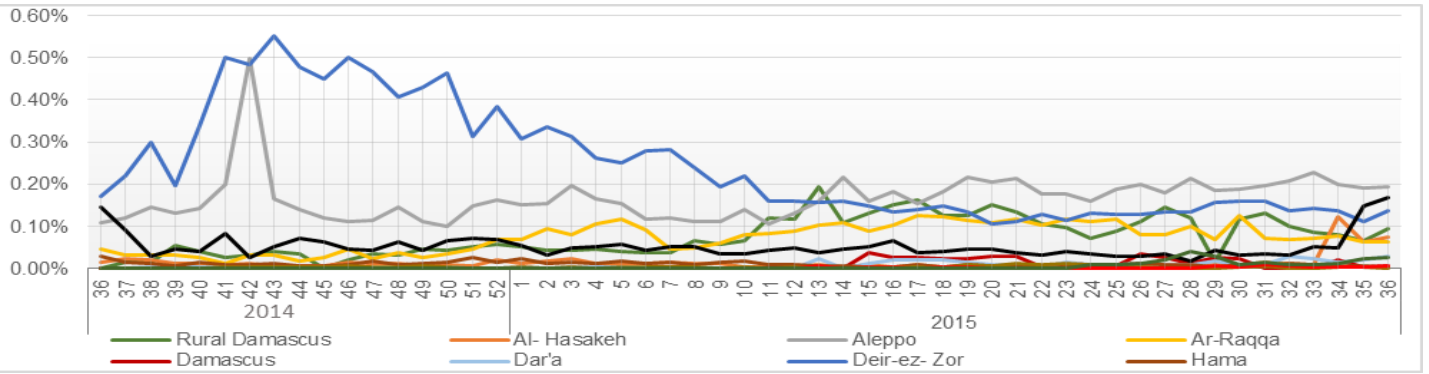


Proportional Morbidity of suspected Measles by Governorate, Epi Week 36 - 2015



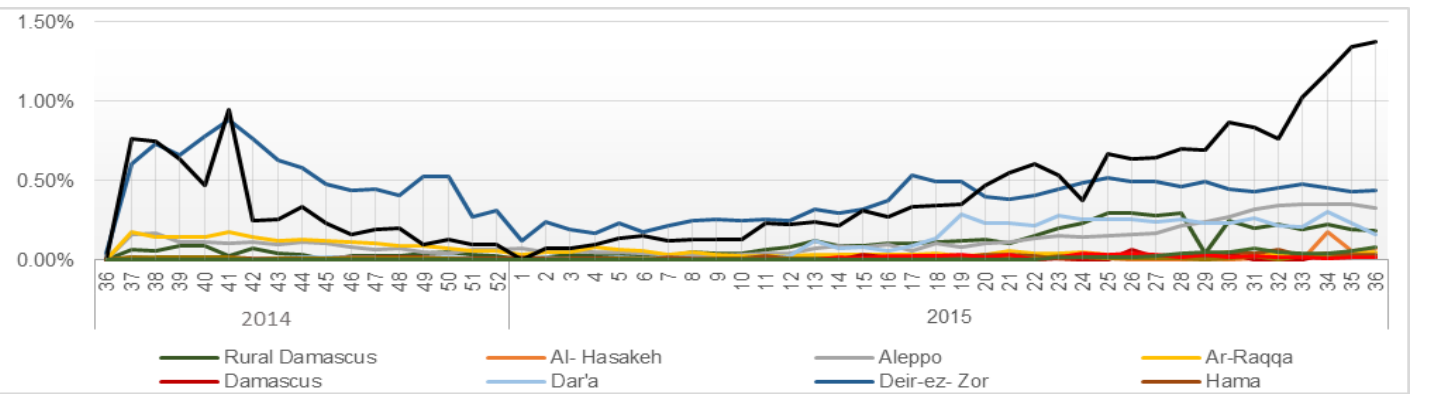
Proportional Morbidity of suspected AJ5 by Governorate, Epi Week
