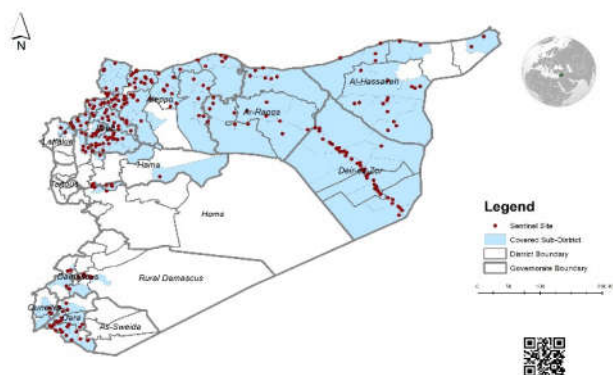


Highlights

- Implementation of 1st polio vaccination campaign in northern rural of Homs on 31th of January and lasted for 6 days . The vaccinated children was 39769 and the coverage was 95,8%.
- During Epi-week no **07, 2016 - 90% (517/466)** of the health facilities across **12** Governorates provided surveillance data. **78%** of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time. **There was a decrease in the number of sentinel centers in al-Hasakah due to the security situation, one sentinel site have been added in Ar-raqqa and Rural Damascus**
- The total number of consultations reported during this week were **162660** (including **40%** children under the age of five) compared to **153427** consultations during week **05, 2016**
- In Epi week **07, 7** AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) cases were reported: **Ar-raqqa 2 – Idleb 2 – Aleppo 1 – Homs 1 – Quneitra 1** Investigation for **37** AFP cases were conducted since the beginning of 2016 up to date. **For more details see weekly Acute Flaccid Paralysis Surveillance report.**
- 76 suspected measles cases reported in this week, the highest alerts reported in Ar-raqqa district (19).
- The number of STF cases (Suspected Typhoid Fever) were 1389, the highest alerts were reported in Deir-ez- Zor (14).
- **888** cases of SARI reported in Epi Week **07**, the highest alert were reported in **Ar-Raqqa 13 - Abu Kamal 8 - Al Mayadin 6 - Idleb 3 - Quamishli 3 - Al Ma'ra 2 - Ariha 2 - A'zaz 2 - Harim 2 - Tell Abiad 2 - Afrin 1 - Al-Hasakeh 1 - Al-Malikeyyeh 1 - As-Salamiyeh 1 - Dar'a 1 - Jisr-Ash-Shugur 1 - Rural Damascus 1**
- In Epi week **07: 7635** cases of Acute Diarrhea were reported and **26356** cases of Influenza Like Illness were reported.
- Common diseases reported under others were : acute bronchiolitis, chicken pox, Brucellosis, Pertussis, Scabies, lice, mumps, Tonsillitis , Impetigo and hand, foot and mouth disease. **30 T.B cases were reported in Epi Week 7 most of them in Ar Raqqa .**
- **2850** new cutaneous leishmaniasis cases reported this week, with alerts **Ar-Raqqa 4 - Al-Hasakeh 2 - Al Ma'ra 1 - Al-Malikeyyeh 1 - Deir-ez-Zor 1 - Quamishli 1 - Ras Al Ain 1**

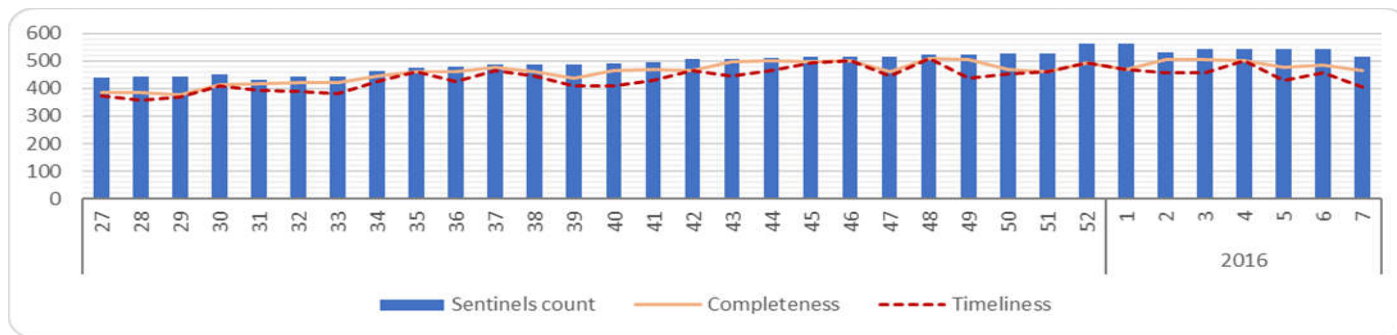
EWARN covers 130 Sub districts and 40 districts in 12 governorates.



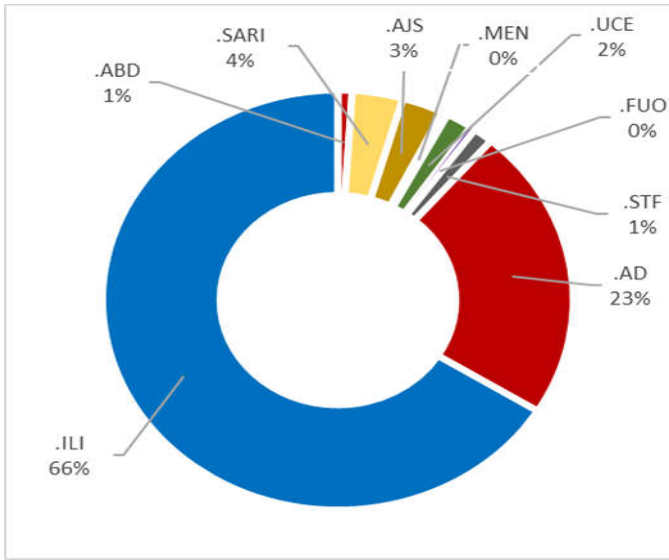

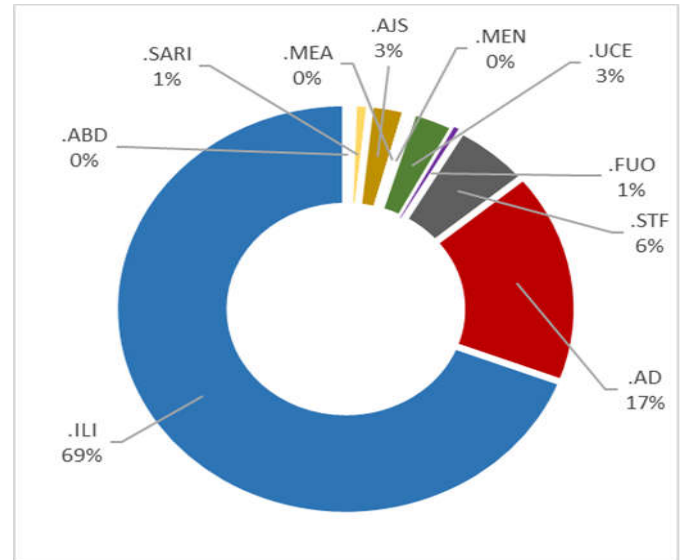

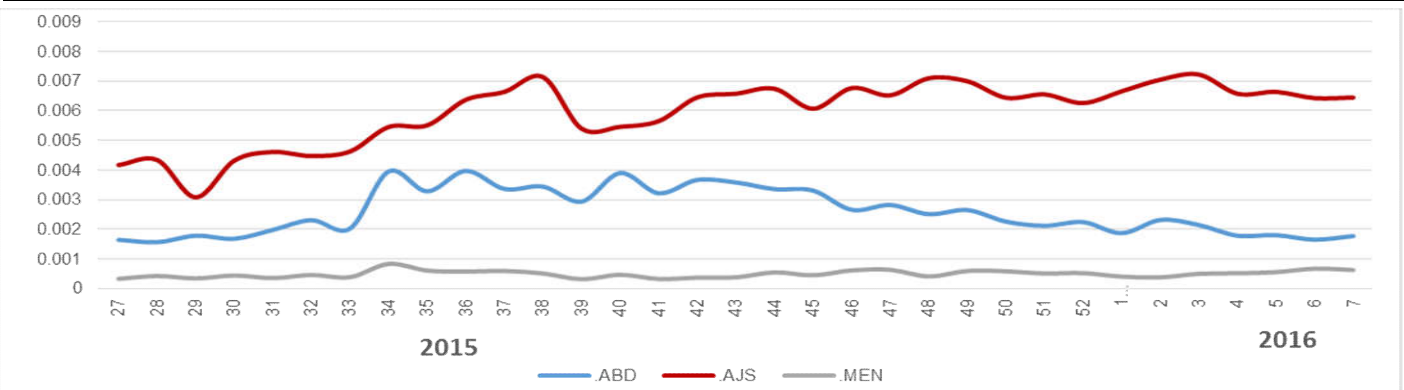
Percentage Syndromes < 5Y



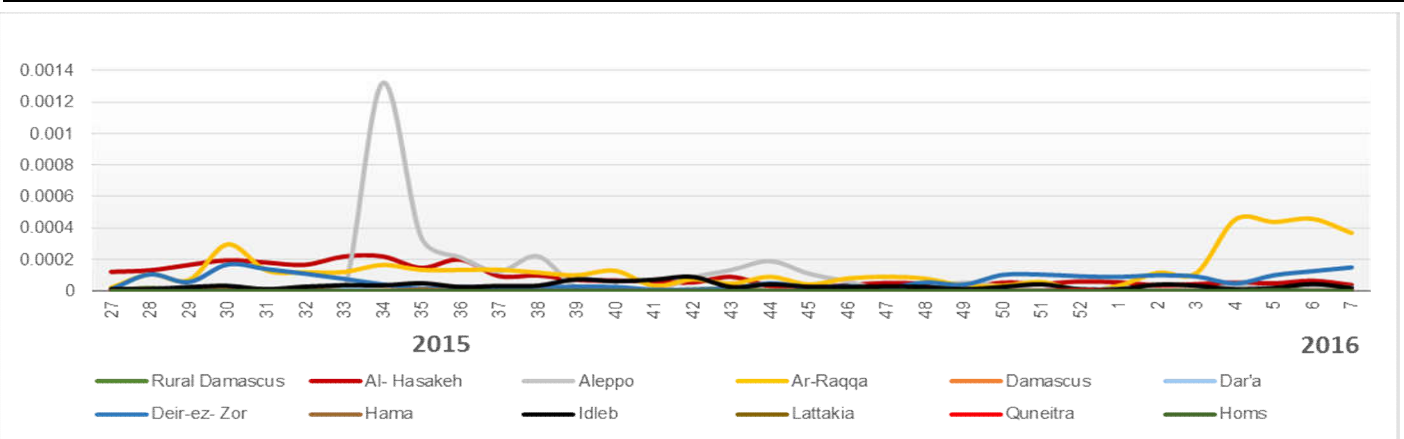
Percentage Syndromes >=5Y

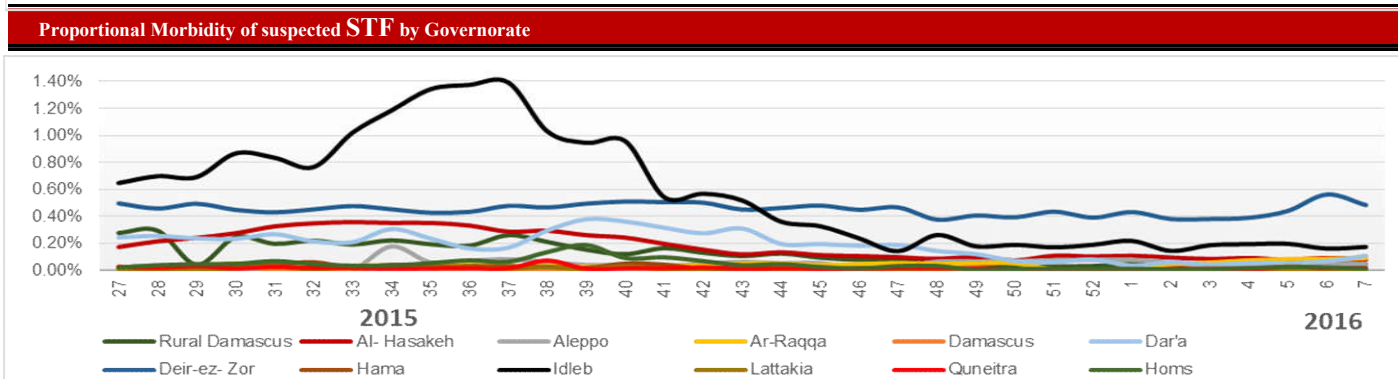
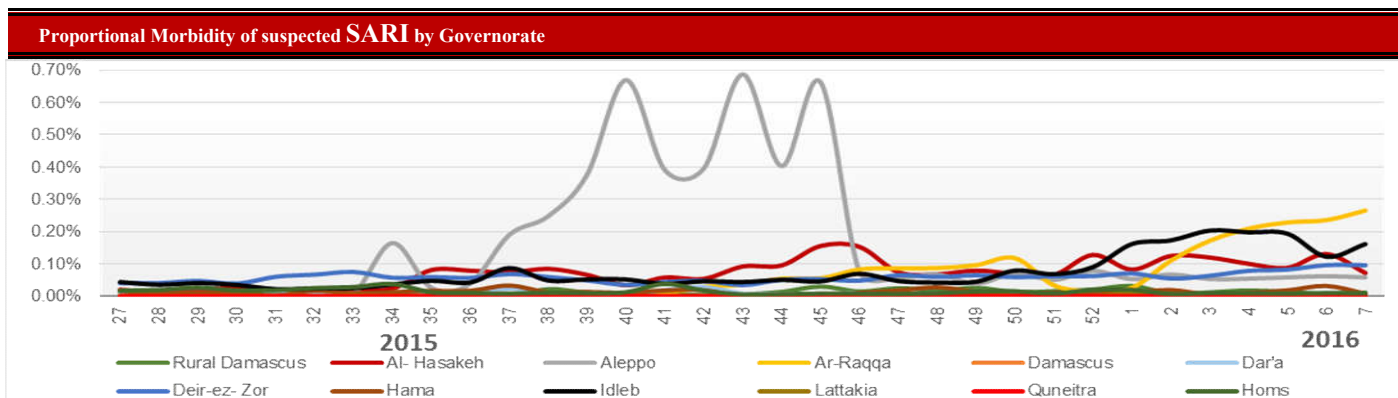


Trends for essential priority diseases in 12 governorates

Response Activities

1. Conduct training for 18 person of SEMA health center in HAMA , including review about early warning and response network , case definition of the diseases in the surveillance list with focus on AFP and Measles surveillance .
2. An awareness campaign about the Influenza in 16 health facilities in east of Dar`a and Quneitra, with a distributing of 5000 awareness brochure in these health centers and the mosques in the region . That activity was done in collaboration with the Injaz institute.
3. Response activities for Lice outbreak in 3 schools in Hara town - Dar`a through the distributing of the needed medication and the awareness brochures.
4. Conduct training about Cholera in Rural Damascus for community health worker teams who operating in 12 town in Rural Damascus, the number of trainees was 30 intern.
