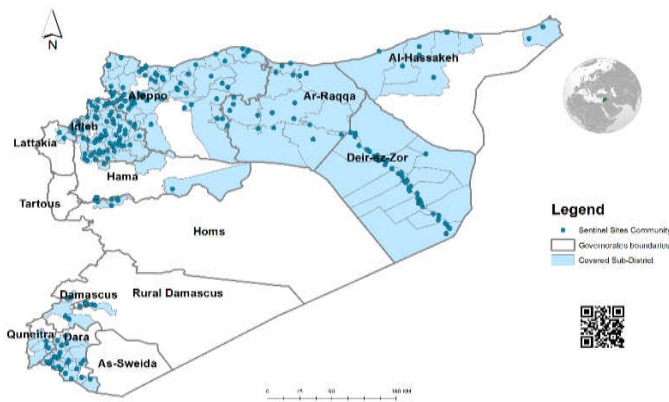


Highlights

- Follow-up Multi antigen vaccination campaigns for AEFI surveillance in in Deir ez zor , Ar Raqqa and Azaz district in Aleppo . The campaign started on 24th of June and will last 10 days .
- During EPI Week 26-2016 , 86% (458/535) of the health facilities across 12 Governorates provided surveillance data. 77% of reporting sites submitted the weekly reports on time.
- The total number of consultations reported during this week were 161810 (including 40% children under the age of five) compared to 168139 consultations during last week 2016.
- In EPI Week 26-2016, 7 AFP (Acute Flaccid Paralysis) cases were reported: Aleppo 3 , Al-hassakeh 1 , Da'ra 1 , Homs 1 , Idleb 1

- 15 suspected measles cases reported in this week, the highest alerts reported in A'zaz 4
Lab investigation for 6 suspected measles cases from Idleb with positive results of Measles IgM in 2 of them.
- The number of STF cases was 2986, the highest alerts were reported in Al Mayadin 17
- 203 cases of SARI reported, the highest alert were reported in Abu Kamal 2
- 15971 cases of Acute Diarrhea were reported and 10313 cases of In uenza Like Illness were reported too.
while AD cases number were duplicated in the following sub district :
- Common diseases reported under others were : acute bronchiolitis, chicken pox, Brucellosis, Pertussis, Scabies, lice, mumps, Tonsillitis, Impetigo and hand, foot and mouth disease. 15 new cases of T.B were reported this week .
- 1518 new cutaneous leishmaniasis cases reported this week, with alerts Al Ma'ra 2
One case of visceral leishmaniasis (2.5 years male child) was reported by MENTOR in Jisr-Ash-Shughur- Idleb.

EWARN covers 124 Sub districts and 39 districts in 12 governorates.



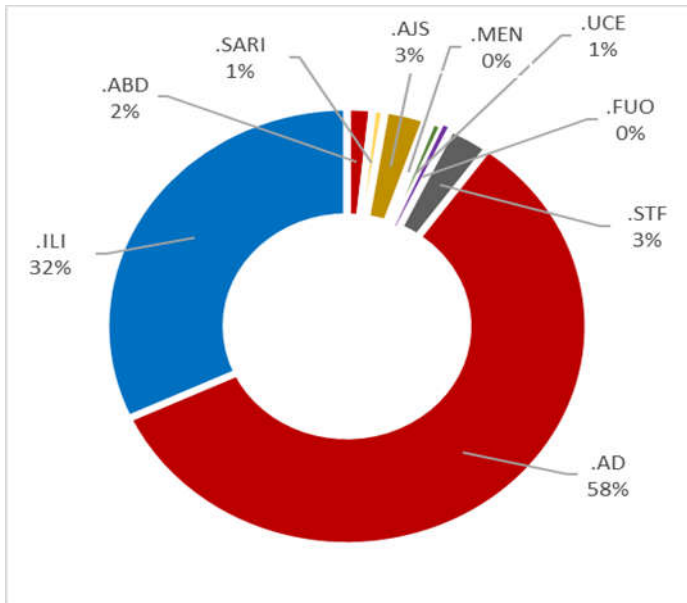

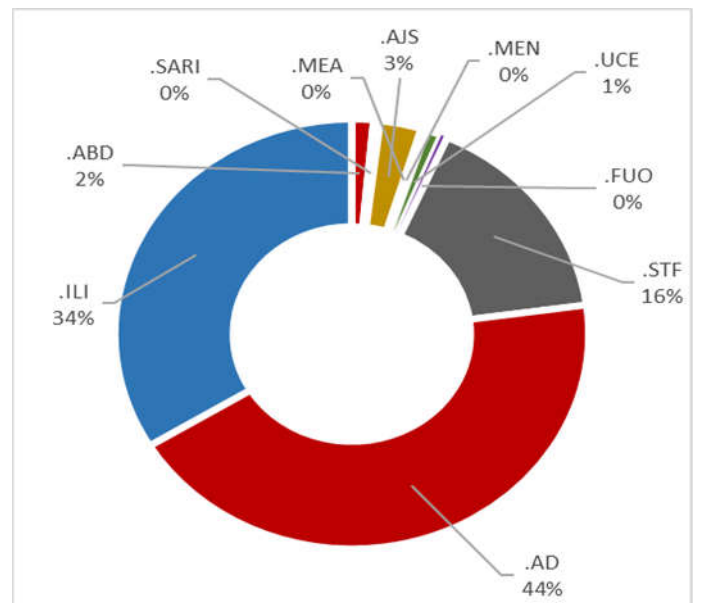

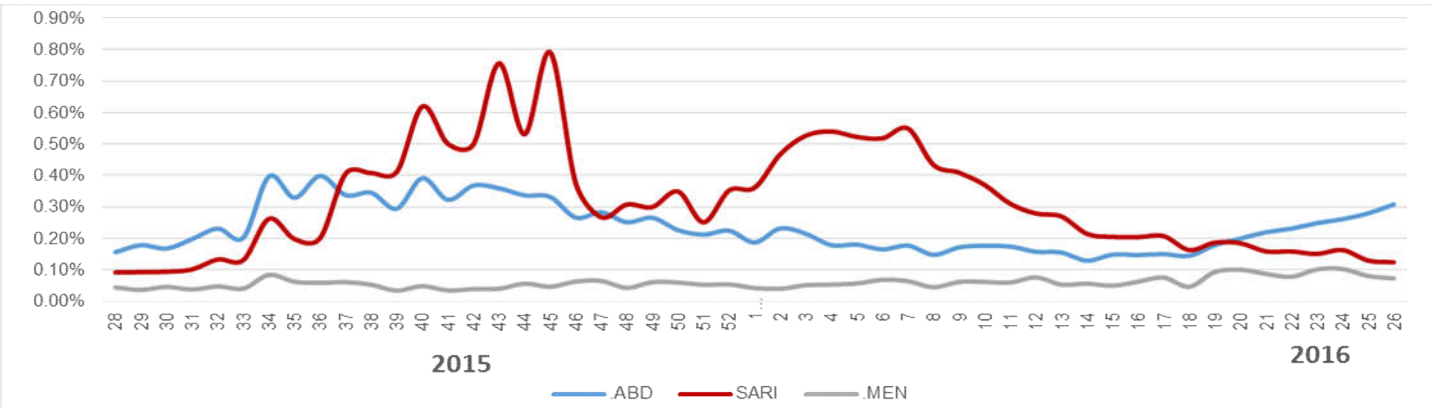
Percentage Syndromes <5Y



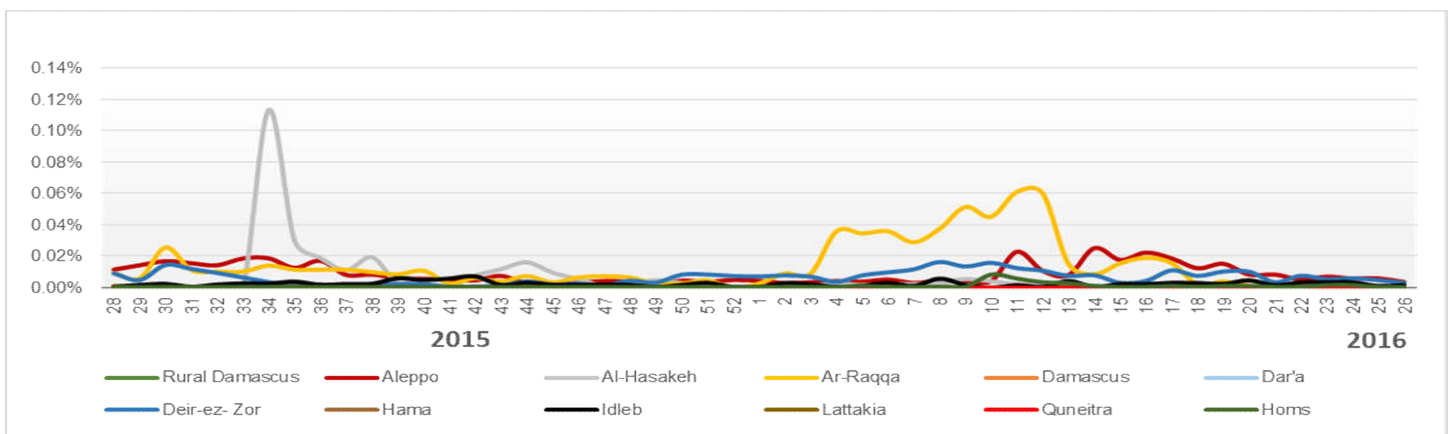
Percentage Syndromes ≥5Y

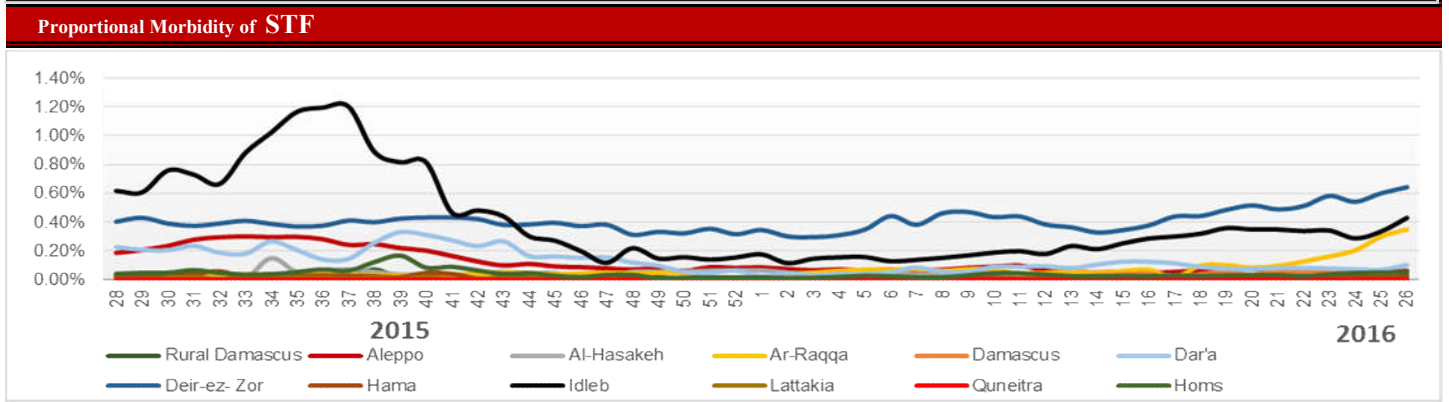
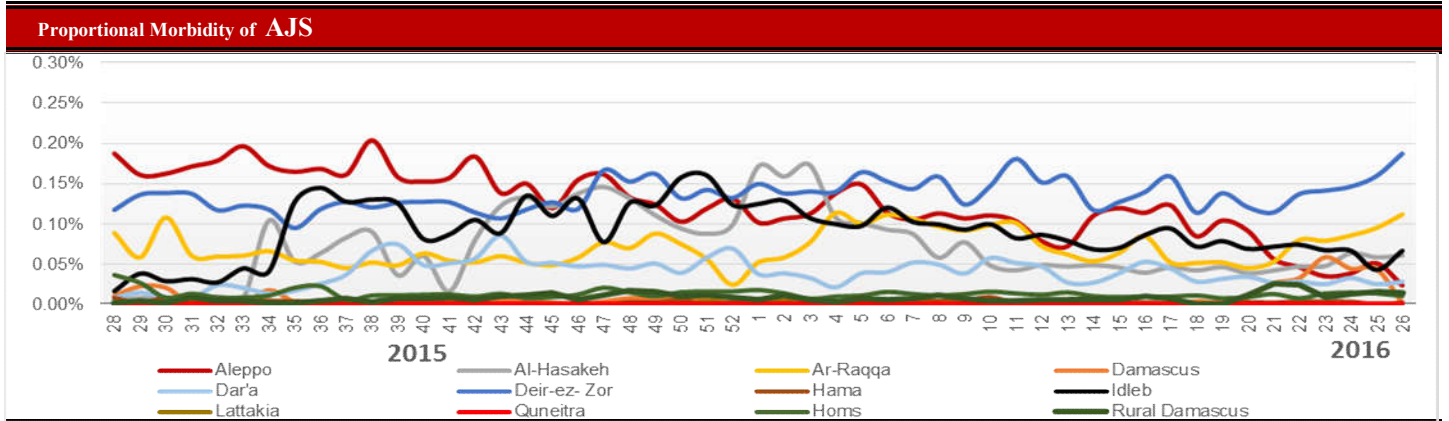


Trends for essential priority diseases

Response Activities

1- Participation in NGOs meeting in Tal Abyad - Ar Raqqa, to discuss and present all activities and projects. EWARN member presented a brief about EWARN and epidemiological surveillance, and the importance of coordination with WASH working partners.

2- A training for community health workers was held in Aleppo city on 24- 25 of May with cooperation with many organization: Space of Hope – Darna – Shafak and IMC. The trainees number was 60 community health workers from the mentioned NGO. The titles included:

- General review of epidemiological diseases surveillance in EWARN.
- Cholera disease: overview, treatment and prevention.
- Methods of water treatment at home and safe storage.

The training was followed by education campaign about epidemiological diseases in general, and cholera in particular, with dissemination of 10.000 fliers and brochures. This campaign was done by 6 teams of the trained community health workers and under supervision of EWARN team in Aleppo city, it is included: houses, schools, neighborhoods councils. This campaign lasted for 2 weeks and targeted 2000 families.
