

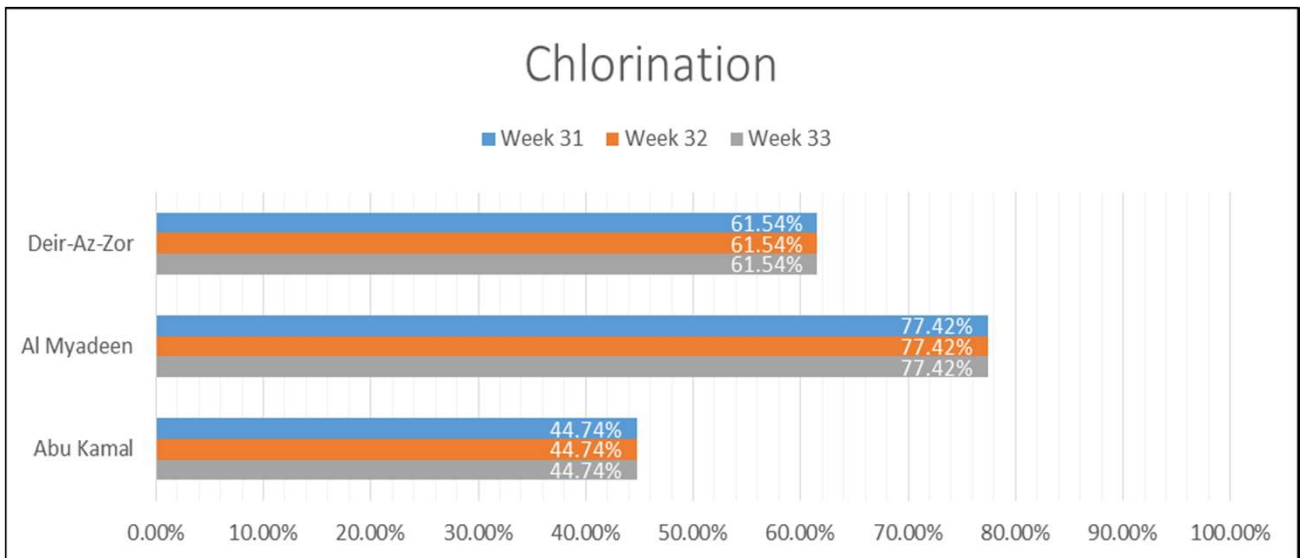

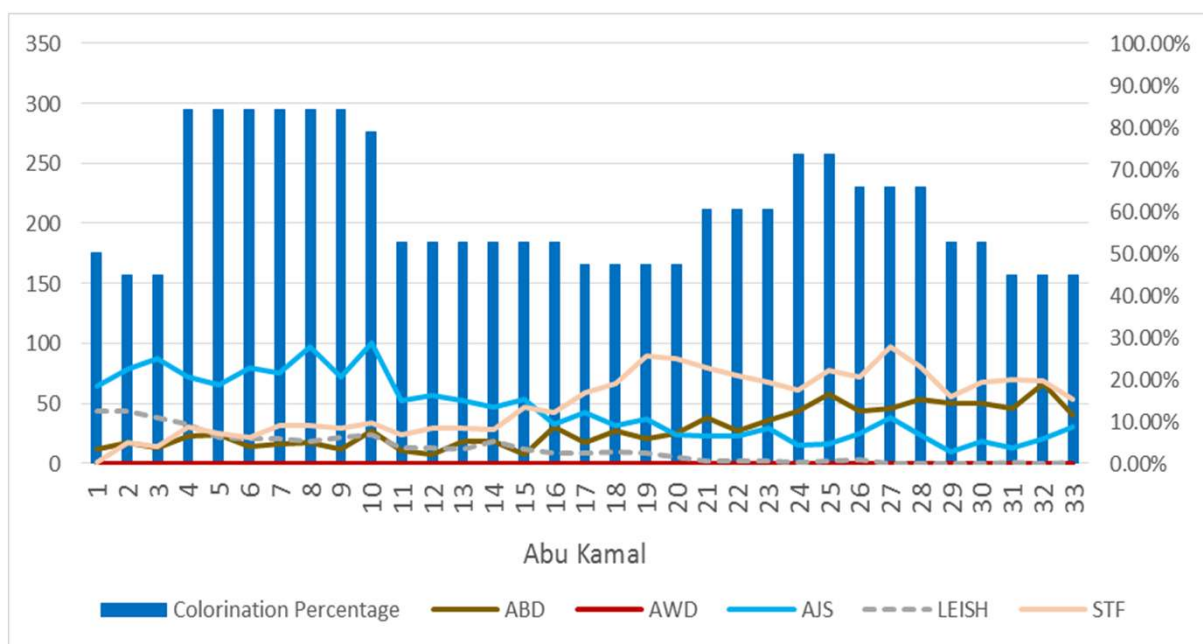


### Highlights:

In these Three weeks, Chlorination percentage in every district remained at the same value, but this value in Abu Kamal district is very low (44.74%), Most of water stations which used Liquid chlorine had Free Residual Chlorine (FRC) less than guidelines. Whereas most of water stations which used powder chlorine had Free Residual Chlorine (FRC) as per guidelines. There is a lack of chlorine in most stations. Syrian Red Crescent and other NGOs provided some of water stations with Chlorine.

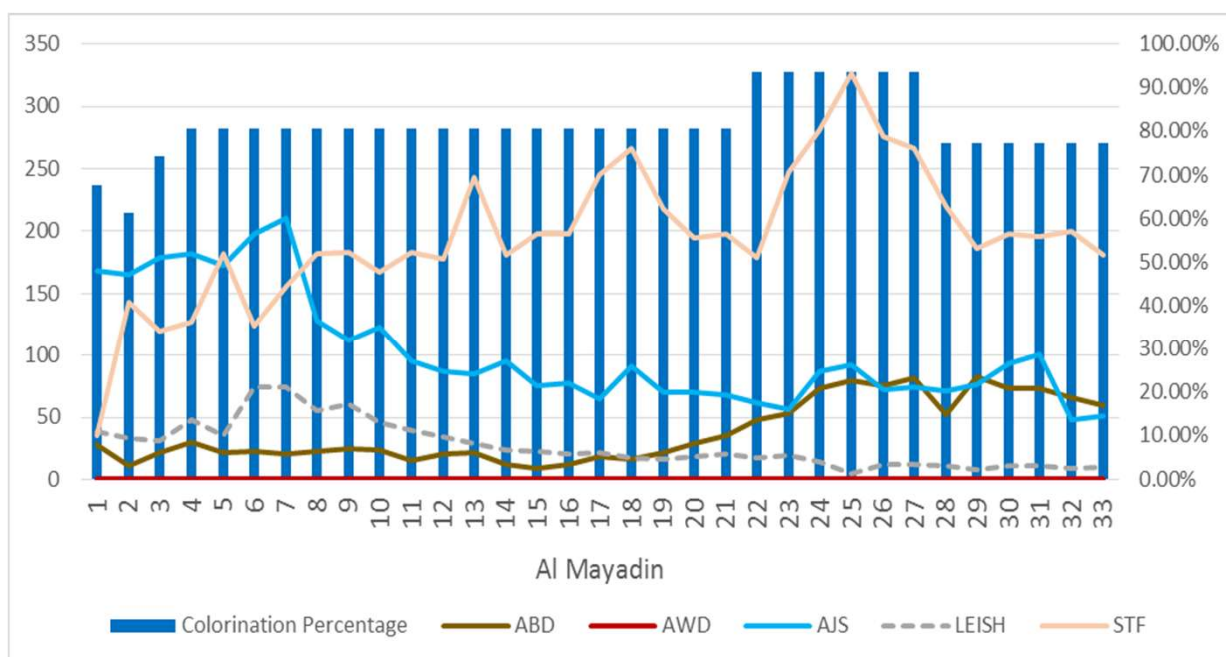
## Abu Kamal

No reported cases of Acute Watery diarrhoea(AWD) since the first week of 2015. Compared to the previous weeks, there was a slight increase of Acute Jaundice Syndrome (AJS) .for Acute Bloody Diarrhoea (ABD) increasing of cases was clear in the week 32 comparable in the others( it is the highest value in this year),Suspected Typhoid Fever (STF) cases didn't change relatively except the last week, it decreased. for Leishmaniasis (LEISH) there is only one case in these three weeks.



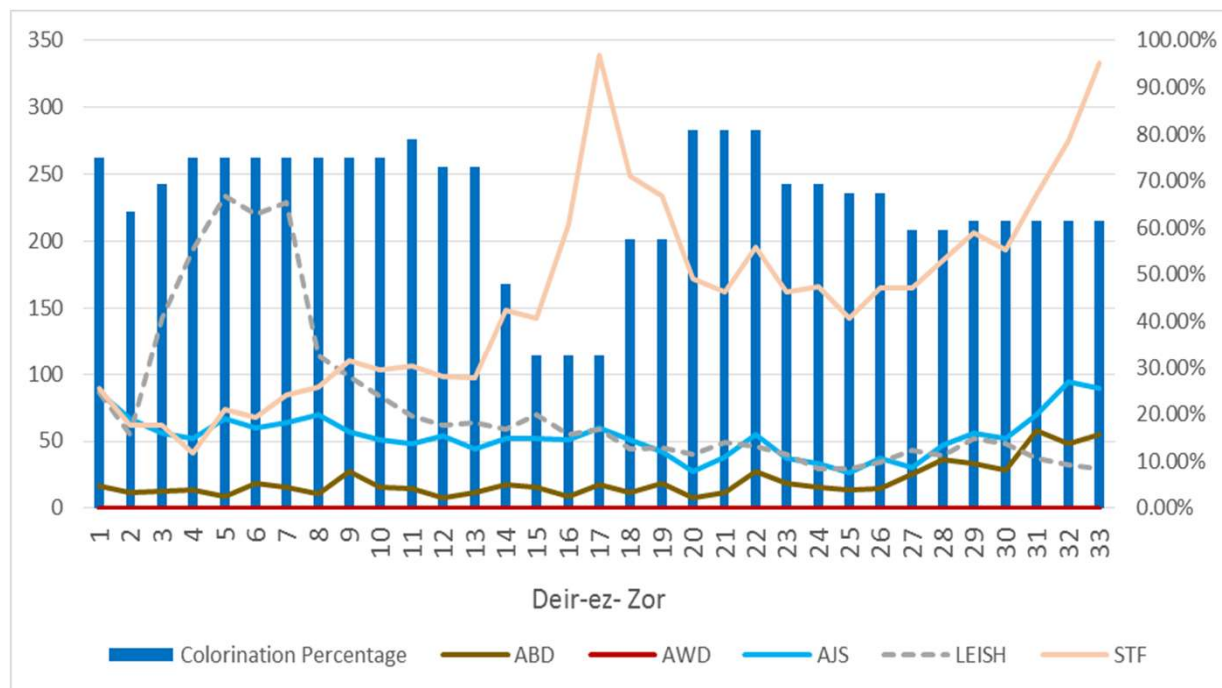
## AL Mayadeen

No reported cases of Acute Watery diarrhoea(AWD) since the first week of 2015. Compared to the previous weeks, there was a slight decrease of Acute Bloody Diarrhoea (ABD) .Whereas there was no change in cases of Leishmaniasis (LEISH) ,but Acute Jaundice Syndrome (AJS) cases were high in the week 31 then it decreased in the other weeks. Suspected Typhoid Fever (STF) cases decreased in the last week clearly.



## Deir-Ez- Zor

No reported cases of Acute Watery diarrhoea(AWD) since the first week of 2015. Compared to the previous weeks, there was a clear increase of Acute Bloody Diarrhoea (ABD), Acute Jaundice Syndrome (AJS) and Suspected Typhoid Fever (STF) cases were the highest in 2015, only Leishmaniasis (LEISH) cases decreased clearly.
